## Message #3: "This cup that is poured out for you is the new covenant in my blood" (22.20).

"New covenant" (a) The Law clarified (chart); (b) Empowerment to obey—Holy Spirit (Acts!)

## **ACTS** (volume II of Luke-Acts)

#### Message #4: Israel is redeemed—by the thousands upon thousands upon thousands.

- Simeon spoke of the "rising of many in Israel": it comes true! (Acts 2.41, 4.4, 21.20)
- Only at story's end does Paul (& redeemed Israel) turn exclusively to the Gentiles (28.23-28)

Message #5: Believers teach what Jesus taught, repentance; and his resurrection, Holy Spirit The 3 things Jesus wanted emphasized (Lk 24.44-49) are indeed the focus of 18 speeches.

#### Message #6: The kingdom comes: what the gatherings (ekklesia) looked like!

- "All who believed...had all things in common; they would sell their possessions and goods and distribute the proceeds to all, as any had need...everything owned was held in common."
- "There was not a needy person among them..." Money and possessions were "distributed to each as any had need" (2.44-45; 4.32-25).
