Message #5: Believers teach what Jesus taught, repentance; and his resurrection, Holy Spirit

For *repentance*: see chart of teaching above, Lk 9:51-19.44; Holy Spirit fulfills promise that with God all things—most especially the striving for salvation—becomes possible. The 3 things Jesus wanted emphasized (Lk 24.44-49) are indeed the focus of 18 speeches.
